BUSA ANTI-CORRUPTION TRAINING PROGRAMME FOR BUSINESS

Background:

BUSA, in partnership with the DPSA and the Danish Embassy is in the process of implementing an anti-corruption project. The project entails developing and implementing a comprehensive national anti-corruption training, communication and awareness campaign for the South African business sector.

Aim:

To promote good governance , transparency and accountability in the business sector.

Objectives:

1. Increased institutional capacity to prevent and combat corruption.
2. Increased capacity within business sector to develop and implement gender responsive anti-corruption programmes and policies.

Training Programme:

As part of this initiative, BUSA will be hosting anti-corruption training workshops nationally. A total of three (3) one day workshops will be held in each of the nine provinces. A grand total of 27 workshops would have been achieved at the end of the training programme, targeting a total of 1350 delegates.

The modules for the workshop cover the following areas:

- Defining corruption
- To educate on the dimensions of corruption. e.g:
 - Bribery
 - Embezzlement
 - Fronting
- Cost of corruption
- Reasons for corruption
- Prevention of corruption
