TERMS OF REFERENCE

BUSA TASK TEAM OF THE TRADE AND ECONOMIC POLICY STANDING COMMITTEE ON ENERGY

PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

This task team has the following objectives:

- Develop positions to address the current electricity supply challenges
- Develop broad based mandates on issues relating to energy policy
- Keep members up to date on developments in these areas
- Facilitate engagement with relevant national departments and state owned entities on issues identified by the task team

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE TASK TEAM MEMBERS

The task team members shall be responsible for achieving the above objectives and any work recommended by the Standing Committee. Policy advocacy shall be through the Standing Committee unless approval is obtained from the Standing committee or the Board.

MEMBERSHIP

In order to ensure the widest possible mandate, representatives of non- member associations may be invited to participate in deliberations of the Task Team, on condition that they co-operate in the development and propagation of a Business mandate.

Quorum

Those present in any meeting.

LEADERSHIP

The Task Team shall elect its leadership, the chairperson and the deputy of whom at least one should both be from a BUSA member in good standing
